

1 BY THE COURT: Anything further,
2 gentlemen?

3 BY MR. JONES: No, sir.

4 BY THE COURT: Mr. Roy, is there anything
5 from you before I pronounce sentence?

6 BY THE DEFENDANT: No, sir.

7 BY THE COURT: Based upon the verdict of
8 guilty that I will authorize to be received and
9 filed, and based upon your conviction for the
10 offense of murder it is my sentence that you
11 should serve life in the custody of the
12 Mississippi Department of Corrections. I will
13 remand you to the custody of the Sheriff for
14 the carrying out of that sentence.

15 Ladies and gentlemen of the jury, I
16 appreciate your hard work in this particular
17 case, but this verdict will conclude your
18 service at this time and conclude these
19 proceedings. You will be released. I do not
20 know if there is a jury tomorrow, but y'all are
21 to consider yourselves excused for the rest of
22 the week. Okay? I will allow you now to leave
23 the courtroom, and arrangements will be made to
24 take you back to the hotel and get your
25 belongings and you will be released.

26 Thank you very much. Everyone remain
27 seated while the jury leaves the courtroom.
