The Court instructs the Jury that you are not to judge the actions of CHRISTOPHER ROY in the cool, calm light of after-developed facts, but instead you are to judge the defendant's actions in the light of the circumstances confronting the defendant at the time, as you believe from the evidence that those circumstances reasonably appeared to the defendant on that occasion; and if you believe that under those circumstances it reasonably appeared to CHRISTOPHER ROY, that he then and there had reasonable ground to apprehend a design on the part of DONG PHUONG NGUYEN to kill the defendant or to do the defendant some great personal injury, and that there reasonably appeared to the defendant to be imminent danger of such designs being accomplished, then the defendant was justified in anticipating an attack DONG PHUONG NGUYEN, then you must find the defendant Not Guilty.
